

Privacy Statement

At our website (arahantechnology.com) your privacy is of utmost importance to us. We want you to have a great experience during your visit to our website and during the process of online purchase on our website. We have attempted to provide you with all the required information related to products and ordering process the products to enable you to transact on our website.

This Privacy Statement relates solely to the online information collection and use practices of arahantechnology.com ("Web Site"). We utilize that many visitors and users of this Web Site are concerned about the information they provide to us, and how we treat that information. This Privacy Statement, which may be updated from time to time, has been developed to address such concerns.

Your use of this Web Site indicates to us that you have read and accept our privacy practices, as outlined in this Privacy Statement.

What Information Do We Collect?

When you visit this Web Site, you may provide us with two types of information :

- personally identifiable information that you knowingly choose to disclose, which is collected on an individual basis, and
- general user information that does not contain personally identifiable information, which is collected on an aggregate basis as you browse the Web Site.

In some cases, if you choose not to provide us with requested information, you may not be able to access some of the content or services.

Personally Identifiable Information you choose to provide

We may ask for certain personal information from you which is necessary to provide you the products and/or services you request.

Cookies/Web server logs: Similar to other commercial Web sites, this Web Site utilizes standard technology called "cookies" and Web server logs to collect information about how this Web Site is used. Cookies are a feature of Web browser software that allows Web servers to recognize the computer used to access a Web Site. How Do We Use the Information We Collect?

We use your personally identifiable information to provide you the products/services that you have requested. When you share personal information, we will not use this information to send you any marketing material unless you have specifically requested it through this Web Site.

Further information about how we use your personal information is provided on our web-pages at the point you submit your personal information to us.

People who have access to personally identifiable information are required to protect the information in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Statement.

We may provide access to your personally identifiable information when legally required to do so, to co-operate with police investigations or other legal proceedings, to protect against misuse or unauthorized use of this Web Site, to limit our legal liability and protect our rights, or to protect the rights and safety of visitors to this Web Site or the public. In those instances, the information is provided only for those limited purposes.

We will not share your personally identifiable information in ways unrelated to those described above without providing you with an opportunity to opt out of such use or otherwise prohibit such unrelated uses.

It is our policy to comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 and all other applicable laws.

Data Security
